Subject: Cricket Machine

Hi all

We are in a bit of a situation, whereby the machine used for the wicket at the cricket which is 7 years old had a blade repair a few weeks ago costing £200, the new blade snapped on first use. After having the machine further examined it needs repairs costing approximately £1250 plus labour. It was intended to replace the machine in 2025/26 financial year.

I am of the opinion that to pay for a repair and then replace the machine is not economic. I am therefore suggesting that we bring forward the purchase of the replacement machine by 6 months. I have had quotations for a replacement which is the same machine as we purchased for the Bowls Greens in 2023/24 (we need two machines for certain jobs) It would cost £6,795. We are currently awaiting a price to trade in the damaged machine, but doubt it will have much value due to the cost of the repair.

I have discussed my proposal with the Chairman & Vice Chairman of the Council and Chairman of HRG, who are all in agreement with my suggested course of action.

As the machine is needed now for renovations, time will be too tight to wait for the next meeting in October, especially if the weather stays cold overnight. Therefore, unless anyone has a strong reason not to purchase, it is my intention to place the order and seek endorsement at the next meeting. You should be aware that Financial Regulations limit emergency spend to £5,000 however we have allocated budget for Capital Items.

Please let me know as soon as possible if you disagree with the proposed course of action.
