Outdoor Team Manager Report

1. Background

This monthly report is to provide the Trustee with a program of works which were carried out in the Welfare Park, over the period of Thursday 26th June 2025 to 29th August 2025

2. Welfare Park Update

2.1 Football Field Main Pitch

- Its been a tough summer, trying to keep the pitch watered, due to the very dry conditions. The new seed which was sown in the spring, required regular watering to bring it on.
- During a brief rain spell we managed to get the pitch fertilised
- In August the season finally got underway.
- Cutting of the playing surface every week, cutting in two directions to enhance presentation, to a high standard,
- Marking the lines out prior to games
- Surrounding areas cut and strimmed every week
- Weed killer applied where required

2.2 Bowling Greens

- Number 1 green is cut three times per week
- Watering has been required twice per week with wetting agent applied, which supports watering sticking to the surface to keep the grass alive during drought conditions.
- Number 2 green: decision had to be made to not water as much as number 1 green as it is impossible to keep them both green during this dry season.
- Ditches surrounding the greens are cleaned out regularly to keep them weed free.
- Bank sides and around the club house are cut and strimmed every week
- Flower beds around the club house watered regularly

2.3 Cricket Field

- During the draught period it has been impossible to keep the cricket out-field watered and concentrate on the cricket square, to keep that green
- Cutting of the cricket out-field every week
- Preparation of the wicket for up-coming games and practices
- The surrounding grassed areas of the field have been cut and strimmed every week.
- The cricket wicket and boundaries are marked out every week.

2.4 Training pitch

- The training pitch is cut and strimmed every week
- Marked out every week
- Checking for litter on a daily basis

2.5 Park Shrub Bed and other grassed areas:

- All areas in the park are cut and strimmed every week
- Weed-killer applied to all areas where required
- Flower beds were prepared by rotavating and fertilising
- Summer beds are all planted but requiring watering twice per week to keep them established during the hot period
- Staff have been kept busy assisting the events manager every Wednesday to help set up the weekly activities.
- Lots of work around the bandstand in preparation for the miners picnic
- Mulching shrub beds, painting troughs etc.
